

LITCHFIELD BOARD OF TRUSTEES
SPECIAL MEETING
JUNE 8, 2020

The Litchfield Township Board of Trustees met in Special Session on Monday, June 8, 2020, at the Litchfield Town Hall after the requirements of the Sunshine Law were met by notification and posting. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Reynolds at 5:00 p.m. with Trustees Horvath and Pope present. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss repairs to some township roads. There was one person in the audience. All stood to recite the Pledge of Allegiance. Trustee Pope stated that there were some repairs listed in the bid for Spieth Rd. work; the bid included 35 cubic yards (approximately 460' of road repairs) of pavement repairs for \$7875 (\$225/yd). Trustee Pope and MC Engineer Dan Becker walked Speith Rd. and noted about 895' of pavement that need to be repaired. Trustee Pope stated that he marked spots on: Stone Rd. - some that the township crew can fix with cold patch, some that should wait to be repaired until next year's chip and seal and some that can be repaired this year; Yost Rd. - 835' of repairs needed; Jones Rd. - 6' wide repair needed to a 80' x 6' patch. Trustee Pope stated that this would be approximately \$25,000 - \$30,000 of repairs. Trustee Horvath stated that the trustees have been dealing with roads long enough to know that if the repairs are not done when needed they will only get worse. Trustee Reynolds agreed that the repairs need to be done. Trustee Pope made a motion to approve up to \$30,000 for road repairs to Stone, Spieth, Yost and Jones Roads; second by Horvath. Voting yes: Reynolds, Pope, Horvath. Motion carried.

Trustee Horvath made a motion to adjourn; second by Pope. Voting yes: Reynolds, Pope, Horvath. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 5:14 p.m.
