

**LITCHFIELD BOARD OF TRUSTEES  
SPECIAL MEETING  
December 1, 2020**

The Litchfield Township Board of Trustees met in Special Session on Tuesday, December 1, 2020, at the Litchfield Annex after the requirements of the Sunshine Law were met by notification and posting. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Reynolds at 4:07 p.m. with Trustees Horvath and Pope present. There was no audience. All stood to recite the Pledge of Allegiance. The purpose of the meeting was for CARES ACT business. Fiscal Officer Shaw stated that the township received \$1058.14 from the redistribution of CARES ACT money. Trustee Pope made a motion to adopt Resolution 17-20 to amend appropriations; second by Reynolds. Voting yes: Reynolds, Pope, Horvath. Motion carried. The trustees looked over bills from Pfaff Electric and Arrow Plumbing that had just arrived. Trustee Horvath made a motion to adjourn; second by Reynolds. Voting yes: Reynolds, Pope, Horvath.
