


**LITCHFIELD BOARD OF TRUSTEES**  
**SPECIAL MEETING**  
**February 5, 2021**

The Litchfield Township Board of Trustees met in Special Session on Friday, February 5, 2021, at the Litchfield Town Hall after the requirements of the Sunshine Law were met by notification and posting. The meeting was called to order by Vice-Chairman Pope at 3:00 p.m. with Trustee Reynolds present and Trustee Horvath absent. There was no audience. All stood to recite the Pledge of Allegiance. The purpose of the meeting was for truck repair. Trustee Pope asked if the Gazette had been notified about this meeting and Fiscal Officer Shaw stated that they had been. Trustee Pope stated that the meeting was called because he had been notified that the plow truck needed repairs that would cost over \$5,000 which is over the limit he can spend with out board approval. Trustee Pope stated that the computer on the 2009 International plow dump truck stopped functioning and the truck was towed to General Maintenance. Trustee Pope made a motion to approve up to \$6500 for repair of the snow plow dump truck; second by Reynolds. Voting yes: Reynolds and Pope. Motion carried. Trustee Pope made a motion to adjourn; second by Reynolds. Voting yes: Reynolds and Pope. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 3:10 p.m.
